Vineyard Locations and AVA's : Caroway Estate Vineyard (Columbia Valley), Sagemoor Vineyard (Columbia Valley), Vinagium Vineyard (Red Mountain)

Vintage Notes: For much of 2009, the accumulated heat units (our way of keeping score for sunshine) were spot on for a long term average. A warm early spring brought out good growth and a generally trouble free bloom and heavy set. The mid and late summer time periods were very warm and promoted intense early ripeness and relatively high sugar for the climate. A somewhat compressed harvest commenced in the 1st week of September with early whites. Reds followed quickly: syrah, merlot, cabernet and exotic varieties. A rare and general killing frost occurred on October 10th. The effects of this frost were minimal for Barnard Griffin; in fact most of our fruit was already harvested. Our Maryhill grower dodged the freeze and our high-elevation Red Mountain source was less effected by the cold weather. Reds are huge in structure, color and dimension. Whites are full bodied, rich and flavorful.
