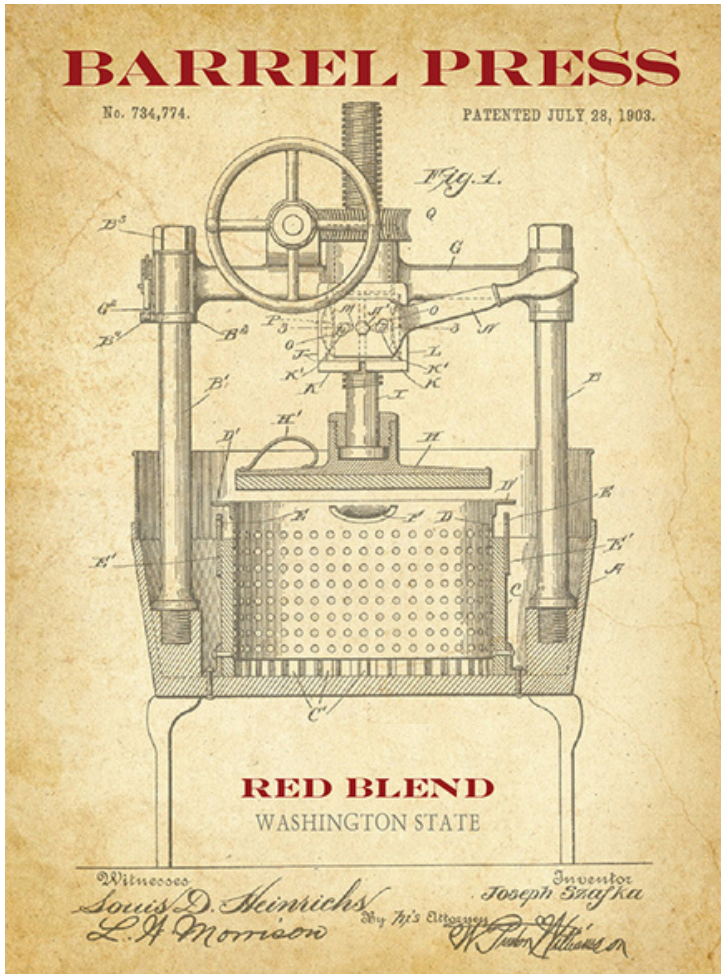


BARREL | PRESS

Wine Notes: Beguiling nose of
vanilla spice, dried fruit, herb and
raspberry candy. Straightforward
plum, cherry and orange fruit on
the palate. Round and
approachable with a supple
texture. Good with everyday
foods such as beef and
barbecued meat.

The label inspiration: Patented in 1903, the Joseph Szafka wine press was a useful improvement in wine presses at that time. The wine press has evolved over time, but remains a crucial tool to modern day winemaking.
